Junior Beef Show
September 3, 2011
Beginning 30 minutes after Sheep Show
No pre-registration is required

1. Show is open to any youth ages 7 to 18 years old or a senior high school student as of January 1st of the current year. The exhibitor and one parent will be allowed free admission.
2. Entries must be submitted on the Livestock Entry form. Entry forms can be found in the fair catalog or can be downloaded from the Rhea County Fair website at www.rheacountyfair.org
3. All animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor or leased by the exhibitor using the 4-H/FFA lease agreement.
4. Current health certificates are required and must be presented when cattle arrive on the grounds. In addition, all cattle must conform to health rules and regulations as outlined and required by the TN Department of Agriculture-Regulatory Services.
5. Exhibitors are allowed only two animals per lot.
6. Judging will take place Saturday, September 3, starting after the Sheep Show.
7. All cattle being shown must be in place by at least 10:00 a.m. on September 3. Animals will be released after this show or after 6:00 p.m. whichever comes last.
8. Classes will be provided for those breeds that have at least 10 entries. Those breeds entered that do not have 10 entries will be shown in "All Other Breeds" class.
9. No bedding will be furnished by the Fair and ***all bedding must be removed*** before cattle are released.

Class 5 -Commercial Beef Heifer Show

1. This class will be judged following the registered beef show.
2. Open to non-registered beef heifers of any breed or combination of beef breeds.
Requirements for this class include:
 - A. Heifers must be weaned.
 - B. Heifers must either be polled or dehorned.
 - C. Heifers will be assigned to lots based on weight.

Class 6 - Prospect Steer Show

1. This class will be judged following the commercial beef heifer show.
2. Open to all registered breeds or combination of beef breeds.
Requirements for this class include:
 - A. Steers must be weaned.
 - B. Steers must be halter broke.
 - C. Steers must be either polled or dehorned.
 - D. Steers will be assigned lots based on weight.

Class 7 - Little Cowbuddies Class

1. Class is open to any boy or girl up to the 4th grade, who is not a 4-H member.
2. Calves need not be owned by the children exhibiting them.
3. All entries will receive a ribbon and/or prize.
4. Open to all beef breeds or combination of breeds.
