General Youth Goat Show Rules

1. Open to all youth between ages 7 and 18 or Senior in high school on January 1 of current year.
2. Entries for the Youth Goat Show are to be made on the Livestock Entry form. Copies may be downloaded from the website: www.rheacountyfair.org or found in the Fair Catalog.
3. The exhibitor and one parent/adult will be admitted to fairgrounds at no charge. No bedding will be furnished.
4. Exhibitor must be present and show their animal unless they have more than one animal in the same class.
5. Health papers for each animal will be required.
6. All goats being shown must be in place by at least 10:00 a.m. on September 3. Animals will be released after this show or after 6:00 p.m. whichever comes last.

1 st place	\$10.00
2 nd place	\$ 5.00
3 rd place	\$ 3.00
4 th place	\$ 2.00

Any breed or cross breed of goat can show and all classes will be shown by weights. There will be a minimum weight of 30 lbs. for all animals showing in this show.

Rules

1. Wether kids must not exhibit any testicular tissue. Animals having this will be dismissed. No bucks or billies will be allowed in or around the barn area.
2. Wether kids and doe kids must have all milk teeth at weigh-in.
3. All goats must be polled or have their horns either tipped or cushioned with a material to help prevent injury to the exhibitor.
4. All goats must have either an ear tag or legible tattoo to be able to show. It is recommended that exhibitors use their USDA Scrapie Tag number as the tag number for all entries.
5. Each exhibitor is limited to 10 animals for the show.
6. All goats will be weighed and classified prior to the show and will be divided into classes.
7. Any item that comes up at the show that is not covered by these rules will be decided by the show committee and their decision will be final.
8. Exhibitors must comply with all applicable general livestock rules and livestock health requirements set forth in this catalog.
